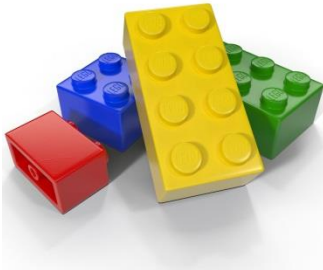
Policy and Procedures

Registration

Registration: all classes have enrollment limits and will be filled on first-come, first-served basis.

Registration Deadline: Thursday February 9

Registration is completed on-line – payment is processed on your credit card.



Cancellations/Changes

Classes that do not meet minimum enrollment are subject to cancellation. If SSDS cancels a class prior to the first meeting, the school will issue a full refund. For cancellations between the first and second weeks of the session, parents will be issued a prorated credit that may be used toward future programs. Cancellations made after the second week of the program will not result in a credit or a refund. Class *changes* will be accepted only after the first week (and *before* the second week) of classes.

Absenteeism

Each club may miss up to two classes due to inclement weather without a make-up offered or a refund issued. After two missed days, the class will have a make-up session as needed, or credit that may be applied toward future After-School Programs.
